

# **CSR Activities**

## **Support for drinking water and Agriculture**

### **Water storage tanks, drinking water supply facility & irrigation support to agriculture**

Continue to provide maintenance and servicing of 5 RO drinking water plants provided for families of employees, schools and health centres.

Arranged three bore wells for drinking water at SreeKumaraswamy Temple with pump sets, pipes and tanks for pilgrims about Rs.5,00,000.

## **Support to health and medical service**

### **Preventive measures for mitigation of mine related health problems**

Extensive dust suppression measures by ensuring avenue plantations, water spraying at stock yard, roads etc.

Supply of filtered drinking water, Fumigation, vaccination and regular health checkup.

### **Promotion of Hygiene and Sanitation, public health initiatives**

1. Counseling villagers on need for using toilets and maintaining hygiene.
2. Regular awareness creation visits by Welfare Officer and lady Counsellor.
3. Five doctors, including dentist, with para medical staff for managing and running Community Health Centre at Sandur - emphasizing on eye care with regular cataract operations by specialists
4. Upgradation of community health center with modern Operation Theatre, Oxygen Plant, X-Ray, ECG, Pathological laboratory, Dentistry, and Physiotherapy equipment to cater to the requirement of employees their family and other villaers.
5. Sunday special consultations by 5 - 6 visiting specialist doctors from Ballari.
6. Construction and maintenance of public toilets with 24/7 water and power

## **Support to Skill development & Education**

### **Skill development & Vocational Training programmes for local communities**

1. Skill Development and employment opportunities to local artisans, mainly Schedule Tribe Lambanis through SandurKushala Kala Kendra.
2. Mirror and Embroidery Training (with stipend) for new Lambani artisans with partial government grant.

3. Training in Skills of Carpentry, Horticulture, Masonry, Welding etc., to about 40 children of the labour prevention school.

4. Vocational Training in Electrical Wiring, Automobile, Carpentry for idle and un-employed SSLC passed youths of Sandur through certification courses from Sandur Polytechnic College.

### **Promotion of Literacy & Education**

1. Contribution to Education Societies for running schools in mining camps.

2. Counseling of school children, especially girls, for awareness of personal problems and for better performance in studies and exams.

3. In continuation of the Company's support in managing and running 15 schools and colleges which cater to about 5500 students and about 300 teachers, entire permissible limit of donation (5%) under the Companies Act, amounting to Rs.1 crore given for infrastructure development for schools in Sandur

4. Contribution towards 295 scholarships for needy and meritorious students in buffer zone villages and Sandur.

5. Payment to salaries to teachers, construction hostel block at sandur Polytechnic

### **Social & Livelihood support**

#### **Support to social, cultural, recreational activities**

1. Contribution to Forest Department for State Level Sports Meet.

2. Contributions for conducting Taluka level and District level Sports meet by local schools.

3. Free use of Company's Community Centre and KalyanMantapa ('Adarsha') for marriages, functions, music programmes, government sponsored awareness programmes etc

4. Contributions for religious institutions, etc.

#### **Livelihood & Socio-Economic standard improvement support**

1. Employment after training of 24 young widows of Deogiri & Subbarayanahalli villages and Sandur Town as Lady Security Guards in local schools for security of girl students.

2. Support to 42 children from poor families of buffer zone villages to prevent them from being exploited as labour and instead providing school education and training skill development by making contribution for management and running of MYG Special Training Centre at Yeshwanthnagar - a Boarding school for education of poor children from neighbouring villages - an initiative for eradication of child labour (Government Programme) a residential r eradication of Child labour..

3. Betterment of facilities, maintenance, toilets, drinking water, seating, boats, life saving jackets and tubes, pathways and hi-tech information centre at the famous Ranganathittu Bird Sanctuary near Mysore - Scheme for adoption of wild-life tourist destination.
4. The Company provides Ration Cards to its employees for ensuring "Food Security" for their dependents by providing a basket of food grains and other products for Rs.115/- per month entailing annual expenditure of about Rs.7 crore.
