Crash in tobacco prices could impact bypolls in Hunsur

There are around 22,000 growers in Hunsur who are upset over drop in demand

The crash in prices of tobacco over the last few weeks has not only led to farmers protesting against the Tobacco Board's failure to come to their rescue, but it now threatens to cast a shadow on the Assembly bypolls in Hunsur, a key tobacco-cultivating region.

The annual auction season for tobacco in Karnataka began in the second week of September this year with the produce commanding a reasonably average price across bright, medium, and low-grade varieties of the produce. But, five to six weeks into the auction season, the demand for tobacco plummeted with no takers, particularly for the low-grade tobacco, sparking protests across different auction platforms in Mysuru district.

According to Mr. Javare Gowda, president of Virginia Flue Cured (VFC) Tobacco Growers' Federation of Karnataka, the price of low-grade tobacco, which was being purchased for an average of ₹120 a kg, had come down by ₹20 to ₹30 a kg.

Angry farmers even held up auctions in Periyapatna last week, accusing the government and the board of being soft on traders comprising the cigarette manu-

facturing companies that were responsible for their plight.

Karnataka Rajya Raitha Sangha (KRRS) and Hasiru Sene, which has taken up the cudgels on behalf of tobacco farmers, said the ire of farmers over the collapse in prices will have a bearing on the December 5 bypolls to Hunsur.

Of the 48,000 licensed tobacco growers in the State, as many as 22,000 are from Hunsur, according to senior Tobacco Board officials. Each licence is linked to a family of three to five adults, besides the labourers engaged to work on their farms.

In addition, there are about 5,000 to 6,000 unauthorised growers of tobacco in Hunsur, said Mr. Gowda.

KRRS leader Badagalapura Nagendra said farmers' issues invariably have a bearing on elections and the plight of tobacco farmers will be no exception. The farmers will show their anger at the polling booth, he warned. The Tobacco Board

officials suspect that the protests by tobacco farmers were "politically motivated" and stoked by leaders of the Opposition parties to capitalise on the mood of the farmers.

In numbers

However, board officials admitted that the price of low-grade tobacco had dipped and the reason was attributed to an increase in its output due to heavy rains and the high yield in areas along the banks of Lakshmanthirtha and other tributaries of the Cauvery in the region. With auctions also commencing in Guntur in neighbouring Andhra Pradesh, the traders had more than one option for purchasing tobacco. Board officials said the prices of tobacco had begun stabilising in the third week of November and hoped that the farmers would get better prices soon.

Mr. Vishwanath, who, after resigning as JD(S) MLA in July, is now entering the fray as the BJP candidate. He will be challenged by Congress' H.P. Manjunath, a two-time MLA, and JD(S) candidate Somashekar.

Vishwanath: I joined BJP at Srinivas Prasad's behest

Reveals that he was asked to take lead in establishing BJP govt. in State

Former Minister A.H. Vishwanath on Friday said that he agreed to join the BJP because of V. Srinivas Prasad, veteran Dalit leader and Chamarajanagar MP.

On his first visit to the BJP office in Mysuru on Friday, Mr. Vishwanath disclosed the behind-the-scenes developments prior to the en masse resignations by coalition MLAs in July. He said Mr. Prasad, with whom he enjoyed a close rapport, had invited him to his residence and asked him to take the lead in establishing a BJP government in the State, with B.S. Yediyurappa at the helm. "He told me to quit as JD(S) State unit president and take the lead in bringing the BJP to power. I immediately agreed," Mr. Vishwanath said, before adding that the two spoke to Mr. Yediyurappa immediately thereafter.

Mr. Vishwanath said that he was told that the BJP's objective would be achieved if a leader like him came forward and took a firm decision. He gave Mr. Prasad the entire credit for installation

of the BJP government in the State.

Mr. Vishwanath, who joined the BJP formally in Bengaluru on Thursday, visited Chamundeshwari Temple atop Chamundi Hills in Mysuru on Friday before visiting the party office in Mysuru to participate in the Kanaka Jayanti celebrations.

Mr. Prasad, however, downplayed his role in establishing the BJP government in the State by claiming that the Congress-JD(S) coalition collapsed on account of the "mistrust and misunderstanding" between the leaders of the two parties.

Acknowledging his friendship with Mr. Vishwanath, Mr. Prasad said the former had resigned as MLA representing Hunsur as former Chief Minister Siddaramaiah had been "humiliating" him.

No reaction

Meanwhile, Mr. Siddaramaiah, who was also in Mysuru on Friday to participate in the Kanaka Jayanti procession, refused to react to statements made by Mr. Vishwanath.

Hampi to get more buggies, minibuses

Facilities are inadequate at present

The Hampi World Heritage Area Management Authority has decided to procure 10 more battery-operated buggies for tourists visiting the famed Vittala temple complex in Hampi. It also plans to introduce minibuses to ferry visitors to different monuments in Hampi.

At present, six buggies ferry visitors for about one kilometre from Gajjala Mantap to Vijaya Vittala temple. Of the 25 buggies procured over the last 10 years, only six are operational, which is woefully inadequate given the tourist flow.

P.N. Lokesh, Commissioner of the authority, said, "The new buggies will be in place before Hampi Utsav scheduled in January 2020." As many as 13 women employed by the authority operate the buggies in two shifts. Each woman operates 20 rounds a day between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Speaking of the minibuses, he said, "We want to introduce a system of a daily pass for travel in Hampi throughout the day. Three vehicles will be doing the rounds on a specific route covering a few monuments."

The local people also feel the need for more measures to facilitate tourists. "Hampi is a vast area, with around 1,600 monuments. It would be difficult to cover the entire area without proper transportation," said Basava, a resident of Hampi, who works as a guide for visitors.

The authority has also decided to study the feasibility of aqua sports at tanks located in Kamalapura, on the Hampi University campus and Sanapura. The commissioner said there was a proposal to introduce trekking, rock-climbing, mountain-biking, and heritage walks.

Test kits at PHCs for rapid diagnosis of monkey fever

With new equipment, test results will be ready in two hours

Soon, diagnosis of Kyasanur Forest Disease (KFD), commonly known as 'monkey fever', could be done quickly and easily at the primary health centre (PHC) level. The National Institute of Virology (NIV), Pune, has developed a point-of-care rapid test kit, which is now awaiting the Drug Controller General of India's (DCGI) approval.

The test kit, developed by the Biosafety Laboratory (BSL)-Level 4 team of NIV, will allow PHCs to test and report positivity within two hours.

"We are now getting the test kits externally validated in other laboratories following which there will be field trials. Simultaneously, we have also applied for approval from the DCGI. Once that is done, the kits will be made available in the affected States," Ashok M., officer in charge of NIV's Bengaluru unit told *The Hindu*.

As of now, Real-Time Reverse Transcriptase Polymerase Chain Reaction (RT-PCR) and serology test using IgM capture ELISA (enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay) are done to diagnose

the disease. This usually takes one to two days for the results.

Moreover, the blood samples from the districts have to be transported to the Viral Diagnostic Laboratory (VDL), Shivamogga, which is the main arm of the Department of Health and Family Welfare tackling the disease.

Point-of-care

"The new rapid test is a molecular test for which blood samples will be drawn and tested at the PHC itself. This will enable diagnosis to be provided at the point of care

within two hours," said Kiran S.K., Deputy Director, VDL, Shivamogga.

Principal Secretary (Health and Family Welfare) Jawaid Akhtar said the use of these kits is one of the many recommendations made by Karnataka to the National Centre for Disease Control.

Cases reported

KFD was limited to the Western Ghats of Karnataka for about seven decades. However, in the last seven years, cases have also been reported from adjacent States along the Western Ghats (Kerala, Goa, Maharashtra, and Tamil Nadu). The rapid test will be of great help in Karnataka, which is one of the worst affected States.

"We are entering into this year's (2019-20) KFD season and are hoping the numbers will be less. We have carried out an aggressive vaccination drive and over two lakh people have been vaccinated from August 2018. In the next one month, over 1.5 lakh more people will be vaccinated. The effectiveness of the vaccine is up to 85% among those who receive three doses," added Dr. Kiran.
