India, Pak to be part of SCO anti-terror drill in Russia

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA New Delhi, July 15

BOOSTING COUNTER-TERROR COOPERATION and dealing with radicalisation and separatism will be the focus of a mega military exercise in Russia next month, in which India, Pakistan and other member-nations of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation will participate, officials said on Sunday.



Around 200 Indian Army and IAF personnel will participate in the exercise at Chelyabinsk city in west-central Russia during August 20-29

Around 200 Army and Indian Air Force personnel from India will participate in the exercise scheduled from August 20-29 at Chelyabinsk city in west-central Russia, they said. All SCO member-countries, including Russia, China, Kyrgyz Republic, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan, will be part of the mega exercise taking place nearly

three months after the top leadership of the security grouping decided to step up anti-terror cooperation in the region and disrupting all financial and logistical support for terrorism. The grouping, in its annual

summit in Chinese city of Qingdao in June, had resolved to deepen cooperation among the member countries to deal with threats of terrorism, extremism and separatism. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Chinese President Xi

Jinping and Russian President Vladimir Putin were among the leaders who had pitched for boosting defence and security cooperation among the SCO countries. "The broad objective of the exercise is to boost cooperation among the SCO countries to deal with challenge of terrorism and extremism," a military official said. Sources said various scenarios to deal with any possible terror strikes will be simulated as part of the exercise focussed on effectively repulsing such attacks.

On the sidelines of the exercise, military officials of the SCO countries are expected to deliberate on ways to enhance cooperation to stop spread of terrorist ideologies and eliminate factors and conditions that facilitate terrorism and extremism, the official said.

Despite Nitish-Shah bonhomie, seat-sharing a challenge for NDA

ALTHOUGH A SHOW of bonhomie between BJP president Amit Shah and Bihar chief minister Nitish Kumar during their recent talks has virtually put to rest the prospects of JD(U) returning to Grand Alliance for the general elections next year, but the seat sharing arrangement among NDA partners in the state could be a challenge.

JD(U) in 2009 but, in 2014 his son Ajay Nishad bagged the seat as a BJP nominee. Similarly, Valmiki Nagar (SC), Jhanjharpur, Gopalganj, Ujijarpur, Begusarai and Arrah were with JD(U) in 2009 which the BJP won in 2014. Ramsundar Das of JD(U) had won the Hajipur constituency in 2009 defeating Ramvilas Paswan then but, Paswan, now a Union minister, snatched it from Kumar's party in the 2014 poll. Karakatt seat was with JD(U) in 2009 but it was won by RLSP chief and Union minister Upendra Kushwaha in the last poll.

There were at least four Lok Sabha seats where JD(U) had come second to NDA winners in 2014 though they had held those constituencies previously. For example, in Munger, the present state minister and a close confidant of the CM, Rajiv Ranjan Singh Lallan, bagged the seat in 2009, but lost there in 2014 to Veena Devi of LJP. Arrah seat was with JD(U) in 2009, but in last election Union power minister RK Singh won it as a BJP nominee.

Dynamics within the NDA has changed after re-entry of Nitish Kumar into the fold last year. During the last Lok Sabha elections in 2014, BJP, LJP and RLSP won 31 out of a total of 40 seats in Bihar while the JD(U), which had an alliance with the Left parties, could manage to win only two seats. BJP and its old allies LJP, RLSP had snatched over a dozen Lok Sabha seats in Bihar which JD(U) had won in 2009 and in such a condition it would be difficult for any party to insist that these constituencies were their stronghold.

There is also likely to be uncertainty in the Madhepura seat which Sharad Yadav, now expelled from the JD(U), won in 2009 but lost to Pappu Yadav in 2014. Pappu Yadav was an RJD candidate, but now separated and formed his own 'Jan Adhikar Party'. The NDA would also have to take a decision on the Jehanabad seat held by RLSP's Arun Kumar.

Monsoon Session: Left to press for PM's reply on communal violence

THE LEFT PARTIES intend to corner the Union government in Parliament on incidents of lynching and communal violence in the country and press for a reply from Prime Minister Narendra Modi in the coming Monsoon Session.

As they chalk out their strategy for the session, that begins on July 18, the CPI(M) and the CPI alleged that recent incidents of lynching and communal violence have "claimed" many lives in the country and the PM should state in the parliament what the government was doing to control the "divisive politics" unleashed by the RSS-BJP. "We would raise the issues of lynching and communal violence in the country in both the Houses of parliament," CPI(M) Lok Sabha member Mohammad Salim said. He said that the government was supporting "divisive policies" and the politics of BJP-RSS, which is spreading violence in the country and that the party would demand a discussion on this. "We would certainly demand an answer from the prime minister."

Holding the RSS-BJP and other right-wing outfits responsible for the incidents of hate crime and attacks on Dalits, CPI Rajya Sabha member D Raja said Modi must answer as to why the SC/ST Act was "diluted" and why so many Dalits are being "killed" across the country. "The government does not want to touch the right-wing organisations with affiliations to the RSS," Raja said.

Ahead of Madhya Pradesh polls, farmers' body to campaign against 112 MLAs

A FARMERS' ORGANISATION in Madhya Pradesh has said it will campaign against 112 legislators, who belong to various parties, for their "failure" to take up the issues of cultivators.

The strategy is to focus on MLAs whose victory margin was less than 5,000 votes in the last state polls. Out of the 112 legislators identified by the organisation, 86 are of the BJP, 24 of the Congress and two are Independents

"We have identified 112 MLAs, who were elected from rural areas but never asked a

question on the issues of farmers in the Assembly," he said. The strategy is to focus on MLAs whose victory margin was less than 5,000 votes in the last state polls, he said.

Out of the 112 legislators identified by the organisation, 86 are of the BJP, 24 of the Congress and two are Independents, Sirohi said. "Our (union) leaders will not go to every village of the identified constituencies, but they will visit

only 20 villages having sizable farmers' population in each Assembly segment. We will interact with farmers and talk about their issues to convince them to vote tactically," he said.

Madhya Pradesh chief minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan had last month said that his government deposited over ₹ 35,000 crore into the accounts of farmers as part of various state-run schemes over the past one year.
